



Guidelines for importing a dog into the US:

- Temporary import restriction from High-risk countries will remain in place through July 2023.
- As of March 2023, dogs from a high-risk country must have a CDC Rabies Vaccination and microchip record.
- Dogs must have a CDC Dog Import Permit:

- High-Risk Countries for Dog Rabies | Bringing an Animal into U.S. | Importation | CDC
- In May 2022 the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices modified the preexposure prophylaxis human rabies vaccination schedule
- 2-doses (days 0 and 7) intramuscular rabies vaccination series replaces the 3-dose series
- Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) | Prevention | CDC
- If a bat is found in a bedroom, testing the bat or rabies
 PEP is recommended if the bat is unavailable

DID YOU KNOW?

>216 Bats were tested at the state lab in 2022 Kentucky saw 1 rabid dog in 2019, 3 rabid dogs in 2020,

2 rabid dogs in 2021

1 rabid dog in 2022.

They were unvaccinated or under-vaccinated and all had skunk variant rabies.
