  - Tuberculosis
  - Immunizations
  - May provide emergency preparedness services, infectious disease control and other services.
- Maintains timely, complete, and accurate documentation in the patient health record.
- Participates in all necessary training to ensure understanding of and adherence to model elements.
- Participates in team meetings, as well as various inter-Department and intra-Department teams, to ensure continuity and consistency in service delivery as defined by protocols, procedures, grants, and program standards.
- Administers vaccines and medications for emergency plans as needed.
- Adheres to nursing standards of practice and follows Department procedures and protocols as well as local, state, and federal regulations.
- Participates in preparedness exercises and emergency responses.
