Position is relevant to (but not limited to) those with various education and/or work experience in Community/Economic Development, Public Policy, Public Relations, Marketing, or Public Health. Master's degree preferred. Skilled in using technology and computers. Strong interpersonal and communication skills and the ability to work effectively with a diverse community.
